Sub:- Action to be taken to facilitate each and every aspiring students to pursue higher studies in degree courses.

Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I would like to state that due to high level of pass percentage of the students in the Higher Secondary final examination 2016, there is a huge demand for admission into the 1<sup>st</sup> year degree courses in different colleges in the state . To facilitate each and every aspiring students to get admission in Degree courses, you are requested to take the following measures as desired by state Govt.

- 1) To increase the seat capacity in the existing shifts or start Morning or Evening shifts as per Govt. guidelines issued vide AHE.353/2013/5 dtd. 11.7.2013 and apply to the affiliating University for their approval .

It may be mentioned that Govt. of Assam in Higher Education Department in a meeting held on 30/06/2016 has already requested the concerned University authorities to allow the colleges for increasing the Nos. of seats or open Morning or Evening shifts.

- 2) To overcome the situation a District Level Committee has been constituted for the Colleges of greater Guwahati with the Principal of B. Barooah College as the Co-ordinator. The Co-Ordinator will allot seats to any of the colleges in greater Guwahati as per availability of the seats in the respective Colleges as reported by the Principals. Similar process may be started in district Headquarters in different places of the state where more colleges are available.
- 3) Due to implementation of free admission to the BPL students whose parents income is Rs. 1.00 lakh or less many such students have applied and taken admission in more than one College. As a result, it has come to the notice of the Govt. that many of the students have blocked more than 1 seat by taking admission in more than one colleges. Govt. has already appealed through the "Assam Tribune" on 3<sup>rd</sup> July/2016 to vacate the other seats after deciding the college where the student desired to pursue higher studies. Therefore, all the Principals are requested to upload the list of enrolled students in their college Web-sites in "Alphabetical manner" and kept the original Marksheet and Certificate of H.S. Examination in the Principals custody.
- 4) It has come to the notice of the state Govt. that many of the well-to-do-family have also admitted their wards by collecting income certificates showing the annual income of the parents Rs. 1 lakh or less. All the Principals are requested to give notice stating that the parents whose income is more than 1(one) lakh should withdraw the wrong income certificates produced to the college authority and pay the fee for admission of their wards within 10<sup>th</sup> July/2016. In the Notice, it should be clearly mentioned that if such wrong income certificate is detected after 10/07/2016 the state Govt. will take any action as it deems fit.
