Greetings from our side!

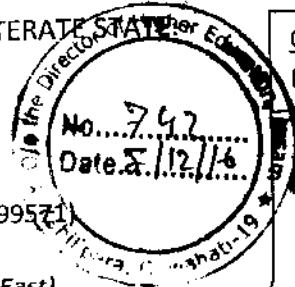
