

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**GUIDELINES FOR AWARDING ONE TIME FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE
RETIRED TEACHER FROM OUT OF THE FUND AVAILABLE WITH NATIONAL
FOUNDATION FOR TEACHERS' WELFARE, STATE WORKING COMMITTEE,
ASSAM.**

1. The National Foundation for Teachers' Welfare was set up in 1962 under Charitable Endowments Act, 1890. The Management and Administration of the Foundation is done by a general Committee under the Chairmanship of Union HRD Minister.

2. Functions: - The main objective of the Foundation is to provide relief to Teachers (and their dependents) who may be in indigent circumstances. The Foundation celebrates 5th September each year as Teachers day to mark the birth day of Late Dr. S.Radhakrishnan former President, noted Educationist and Philosopher. A voluntary campaign for the collection of fund for the welfare of teachers is also undertaken on this day.

3. State Working Committee:

There is a State Working Committee of NFTW headed by the Education Minister of the State as Chairman. The Committee is as under;-

a) Hon'ble Minister Education	Chairman
b) Principal Secretary, Education	Member
c) Director of Secondary Education	Member Secretary
d) Director Elementary Education	Member
e) Director, Higher Education	Member
f) Chairman/Secy SEBA	Member
g) Chairman /Secy AHEC	Member

4. The State Committee of the National Foundation for Teachers' Welfare proposes to award one time financial aid to the Retired Teachers of Elementary and Secondary Schools and Colleges from out of the fund received from sale of Tickets and token for Teachers Day and from out of the fund realised from publication of advertisements published in the souvenir published on the occasion of Teachers Day.

The Benefit of the Scheme will be open to Retired Teacher of Govt and Provincialised Elementary / High and Higher Secondary Schools and Colleges for the current year.

A teacher who is suffering from any of - i) Cancer ii) who have undergone Heart surgery iii) Have under gone Kidney transplant (iv) Have met serious accident resulting in loss of either one hand or one limb during the period of last 3 years (ie. after 01.08.2013) is eligible to apply for Financial Aid.

5 .Quantum of Assistance: Quantum of assistance may vary from Rs. 10000.00 to Rs. 25000.00 as one time grant. Total amount of the grant will be limited to Rs. 12,50000.00 to be given this year.

The needy Teachers may submit application to the Inspector of Schools and the District Elementary Education Officer of the District or the Principal of the College as the case may be directly with a copy to Director Secondary Education by Registered Post or by hand .

The IS /DEEO /Principal as the case may be shall countersign the application to certify the authenticity of the application

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6. There shall be a State level Committee to approve the name of beneficiary and quantum of grant against each of them.

The State level Committee will scrutinise the applications as recommended by the IS/DEO/Principal and select the names of beneficiaries and will fix quantum of assistance for disbursal.
