It has come to the notice that some Provincialised Colleges of Assam has submitted proposal to this Directorate for regularization of services of non-teaching staff against the valid sanctioned posts.

Govt. of Assam vide O.M. No.B(2)H.97/2003/135, dated 12-10-2004, has banned the appointments of teaching and non-teaching staff against non-existing posts of deficit grants-in-aid colleges (now Provincialised).

Therefore, all Principals of Provincialised College are directed not to submit any proposal to this Directorate in this regards.


However, Govt. vide letter No.AHE.395/2016/15, dated 04-10-2016 has approved for filling up of 114 nos. of vacant sanctioned post of Grade-III of various provincialised colleges of Assam, you may collect the names of candidates from your concern District Employment Exchange as admissible as per rule. No regularization proposal against these posts shall be entertained.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub : Prohibition for engagement of teaching and non-teaching staff in deficit grants-in-aid Colleges without any sanctioned posts.

In continuation of this department's O.M. No. B(2)H. 97/2003/98, dtg. 17.7.2004 the following procedures/moralities are prescribed for banning the appointments of teaching/non-teaching staff against non-existent posts in deficit grants-in-aid Colleges.

2) Henceforth, no College under the deficit-grants-in-aid system shall engage any person for a teaching or non-teaching work where no sanctioned post exists for the purpose. For the purpose of filling up of vacant sanctioned posts, existing Government instructions/guidelines will continue and approval of competent authority will be taken without fail.

3) All members of the Governing Body of the College, including the Principal/Secretary of the College will be responsible for any violation of the above-mentioned conditions.

4) The Member Secretaries of the respective Colleges shall invariably submit reports of compliance to above conditions twice in a year : the first report as on 1st April of the year and the second report as on 1st October of the year, as a precondition for release of fund to such Colleges by the State Govt.
