Dear Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma ji,

Please refer your letter dated 25th July, 2016 requesting to delink the beneficiaries of Ishan Uday from the mandatory requirement of Aadhar citing the reason that Aadhar card scheme has not been implemented in Assam.

In this regard, an O.M. dated 17th August, 2016 has been issued by Director (Scholarship), MHRD, stating that the DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat has taken a decision that as an interim arrangement, Scholarship could be disbursed directly into the Jan Dhan account of the students and their identity established through any of the KYC documents, such as, birth certificate or school certificate. DeITY has made provision for registration of students from Assam without Aadhar on National e-Scholarship Portal (NeSP-2.0).
